

Town of Conklin – 2027 Tax Exemptions

Discounts for School and Property Tax

DEADLINE MARCH 1st, 2027

1. Please read and answer all the questions on the forms. Provide ID, if not currently on file.
2. Do not fill in your income; the Assessor's Office will complete this section.
3. **Proof of 2025 income is required.** If you file your taxes, this would be a copy of your 2025 Income Tax Return; Federal or State. If no return is filed, then you will need to provide the year-end statements (Ex. Social Security Benefit Statement, pension, interest, dividends, annuity income, rental income, and alimony income, Veteran's income.)
4. Additional contact information is suggested, for example: relative, friend, neighbor; If applicable, supply any recent death certificates, Power of Attorney, or copies of Trusts.
5. Sign required forms:

Your local assessor's office can only accept the following exemption applications: Senior Low Income, Disability, and Veterans applications or renewals.

Basic and Enhanced STAR applications must be done online in the Homeowner Benefit Portal at www.tax.ny.gov/star or, should you not have access to a computer, by calling 518-457-2036, weekdays between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

If you are unable to make the required copies for verification of income, you may mail or bring your originals to us, and we will make copies and return the originals to you.
